

MILDtheGAP: using Manufacturing Labour Demand to reduce the Skills GAP between Market and VET offer

Main objective of the project:

The project, focused on the Manufacturing sector, aims at reducing the skills mismatch between the Training offer and the Skills Demand (relating to some specific occupational profiles).

To achieve such a goal a skills gap analysis will be performed between the Labour Demand and the current professional training provided (EQF level 4) in the involved countries in order to integrate the related curricula.

The gap analysis will lead to the integration of curricula in terms of skills.

The final goal is to train professional figures appealing for the companies and easy to place

on the market since they respond to the real needs expressed by companies.
