Vision of the project

Call for action regarding global responsibility has been made since 2015, when 17 Sustainable Development Goals were designed by the United Nations, in order to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. These goals were included in the 2030 Agenda, thus having a 15 years time-frame to be achieved. However, with just one decade away from the deadline of 2030 Agenda's implementation, there is still much to be done.

In order to increase the chance of achieving the Sustainable Development Goals by the end of 2030, there is a need to encourage action regarding global responsibility, especially when addressing young people. Their future and next generations' future is directly impacted by their behaviour towards the environment. As such, a sense of ownership regarding global responsibility should be enhanced among young people.

The aim of the project is to give youth workers tools to encourage young people to take responsibility for sustainable development.

Objectives:

- To give youth workers tools to raise young people's awareness on the importance of sustainable development;
- To give youth workers tools to improve young people's knowledge on Global Responsibility Education;
- To strengthen youth workers' competences in providing Global Responsibility Education for young people;
- To give youth workers tools to address 3 selected goals: Clean water and sanitation (Goal 6), Life below water (Goal 14) and Partnership for the Goals (Goal 17);
- To give youth workers tools to create or strengthen partnerships on Sustainable Development;

Activities of the project:

In order to meet the aim and objectives, a Training on Global Responsibility will take place during 8 working days, in Vadul lui Voda, the Republic of Moldova, in September 2020 (expected date: 21.09.2020 – 28.09.2020).

The target group consists of youth workers from the partner organizations, who have an interest in improving their skills and knowledge regarding Global Responsibility Education and non-formal education methods.

Participants will obtain tools to foster Global Responsibility Education (GRE) in their activities with young people, through specific GRE and non-formal education methods. They will exchange ideas and benefit from relevant stakeholders' expertise. Thus, they will improve their competences regarding Global Responsibility Education and non-formal education methods.

Partner Responsibilities:

It is the overall responsibility of all partners to make sure the aim and objectives of this project are aligned with their organisations and to adhere to the Memorandum of Understanding.

The partners are expected to nominate 3-4 participants for the activity, who are relevant to the topic of the project.

Prior to the activities, the applicant organisation will provide detailed information regarding the preparation of the participants. The partners are expected to ensure that the selected participants are well prepared in every way. For example: language, expectations, travel arrangements etc.

After the project, participants, together with their organisations, will disseminate the results, to create visibility of the project and utilise the learning outcomes. The project manager and participants will come up with dissemination strategies as part of the project.
