### Call for Erasmus + Mobility of Youth Workers Partners Autumn 2020

Hello!

If you are receiving this message it's because we believe your organisation can be a good match for the **Erasmus + Mobility of Youth Workers** project we are applying for.

**Joyce 'n' Fun (GR)** organisation is planning two hands-on mobilities for fall of 2020. A 15 days residential program training in September aiming at spreading the knowledge, skills and attitudes of natural building and a 15 days residential program training in October that combines **Permaculture** theoretical & practical lessons with a focus on Regenerative practices.

Both projects are addressed to participants issued by different EU countries who represent organisations that are already working in the field of ecology and sustainability or who are interested in and learning about sustainable living practices. The programs will take place in a permaculture farm, on the island of Skiathos, Greece.



This is an opportunity for students, trainees and young people, as well as for professors, teachers, trainers, youth workers, staff of education institutions and civil society organisations to undertake a learning experience in another country.

Every young person or youth worker taking part in this youth mobility project is entitled to go through the Youthpass process and receive a **Youthpass certificate** at the end.

**Contribution** : 130€ per participant

**Accommodation** : camping on site

**Partners** : 100€ per partner organisation for their support.

As a **Sending Organisation** , you will be in charge of sending young people and youth workers to Greece (this includes: organising practical arrangements; preparing participants before departure; providing support to participants during all the phases of the project).

If you would like to take part as a participating/sending organisation, your organisation must be:

- established and registered in a EU country;

- working in at least one of this fields: sustainable development, agro-ecology, renewable energies, alternative education, training, youth, migration (including refugees and asylum seekers), socio-economic/ethnic/sexual minorities, disabilities and special needs.

If you have the needed requirements and you are interested in having more specific details about the project, please contact us so that we can bring this conversation further.

If any problems occurs because of the covid-19 pandemic, the trainings will be postponed to later dates.
