



Inclusion through Solidarity Training Course

Project description

The Inclusion through Solidarity project aims to combine **Erasmus+** and **European Solidarity programs**, as a tool for the **NEETs youth inclusion**.

Type of activity: Mobility of Youth Workers

Venue of mobility: Bucharest, Romania

Dates: 15 - 23.01.2021

Project objectives

1. Improve the organisational capacity of 9 NGOs for **developing inclusion projects**, by promoting ESC program as a solution to youth unemployment;
2. Develop a common understanding for 29 participants on **how to design an ESC projects** with a view to quality, based on the inclusion needs of NEET youth;
3. Empower 29 youth workers in **managing top-quality ESC projects** by exchanging experiences and good practices, good management of the project, inclusion strategies, analyzing characteristics and jointly finding solutions;
4. Establish **lasting partnerships among 9 NGOs** from European Union and Eastern Partnership Region and jointly develop min. 5 ESC projects in 2021;

Participants

The training will involve 29 youth workers aged 18+ **from the partners NGOs' staff** (volunteers, social workers, educators, counselors, trainers and other related staff implementing non-formal activities), who are actively involved in the NEETs' inclusion process, interested in the topic of solidarity and who are motivated to use ESC tool in their mission.



Participants' preparation

There will be a mandatory preparatory/introductory phase pre-mobility, aiming to introduce basic information in order to establish common grounds, as well as provide a place where participants will start to form a community of learners and will carry out first homework and assessments in their own organisation, local community and own needs.

Each NGO will **organize a pre-departure training session** with their participants between 01 and 31 of December 2020, after the participants' selection process will be completed, discussing the info-pack related issues such as: Erasmus+ program, financial aspect, Youthpass and evaluation methodology within the mobility, topic related home-work, travel, inter-cultural evenings preparation, NGOs presentation preparation, etc.

Project results

- 2 E-guides (10 pages each) which will be collections of info, materials, tools, know-how and other relevant info for other youth workers and NEET youth. Both will contain info on the project, the mobility, activities, outcomes, etc. but designed for two different target groups (youth and youth workers).
- 4 new European Solidarity Corps projects among the partners applied in 2021;
- 1 Official Facebook page (600 followers) and 1 Instagram page (200 followers);
- 1 Facebook group (Inclusion through Solidarity HUB) with 200 youth workers members.
