

Call for partners - Projecting

What is it?

Cherry International Foundation is looking for partners from programme countries who are interested in a project focused on increasing the skills regarding project writing and project management.

More specifically the training content will be mainly on how to apply for funds at regional, national and European level; what is needed for it, how to fill a social need, how to create a programme and how to address the project management. We see that many persons and organizations are willing to organize an (international) project and to make use of different funding programmes, though many persons get lost in the administration and the steps in order to get a grant. Through this training we want to train the participating youth workers on how to work within this structure of project management, how to include youngsters in your projects and the importance of it in Youth work.

We work with real life cases, so persons who attend the training come already with an idea in mind in order to explore and develop during the actual training.

When and where?

The training will take place in the last week of November, 2021 (under reservation) for 6 working days. The training will take place in group accommodation Olde Vechte in Ommen, The Netherlands (www.oldevechte.nl). We will apply on October 1, 2020.

Phases of the project

Phase 1 - Introduction

During the preparation phase we do online assignments and the members of your organization define on what they want to learn and what is needed for your organization and target group you are currently working with regarding project management and acquiring funds in order to realize a project.

Phase 2 – Implementation

During the training we will train youth workers and members of your organization skills and competences related to project management, fundraising, applying for Erasmus+ grants, applying for other types of subsidies, what is needed in order to get subsidy, etc.

Phase 3 – Post-training

In the training we make agreements and learning goals with each member of your organization individually. They will work on this goal related to project management in your community and how to involve the community in their work.

Phase 4 - Dissemination

During this stage we evaluate the 'after training' and share the results from each step in the project management post-event and how the youth workers are currently implementing the learnt outcomes of the training in practice. A Google Drive will be created with project management tools in youth work.

For who?

The training is for youth workers, youngsters, volunteers and members of your organization who want to learn more on how to apply for projects using different subsidy programmes such as Erasmus+, European Solidarity Corps, Council of Europe, etc. We aim at finding partners with the same geographic and social background. Coming from the same background also enables us to create a more distinctive dissemination product and in the sharing/caring moments to create a unified platform. In this training 3 members of your organization can participate.

The training will be facilitated by Eddie Wolters who has experience in working in an international context in exchanges, trainings, ESC and EVS projects, working with funds, sponsors
