Our spheres of action are:

■ **YOUTH MOBILITY IN EUROPE**

That's our main focus. It has a positive effect on young people on several levels: personal, employability, European feeling and tolerance towards diversity.

■ **ARTISTIC MEDIATION**

Using the active and resolving participation in the problems that afflict society with artistic experimentation means making everyone's skills accessible and meaningful.

■ **SOCIOCULTURAL PROMOTION**

We believe that all young people (and not) deserve to grow up in a community where quality services, opportunities and support are offered.

The experience of the association is relevant for the project:

Coordination as sending volunteers in: Spain, Germany, Greece, Portugal, Sweden, Finland and Bulgaria. As former EVS volunteers our main focus is on the preparation of outgoing volunteers (in this case) with special attention to their rights/duties.

We support the volunteers by training them with a Skype or in person before the project, providing them with NA guides and personalised guides. Along the way we continue to follow them through the course of the project on Whatsapp and Skype, and at the end of the course we organize an additional Skype to both

reintegrate them into their starting culture and help them find other work/volunteer/travel opportunities.

■ **Support of local volunteers:** as a support we also organize projects on site. In this case we look for partners who have the same vision/mission as us and who are close to art and culture, being one of our main focuses. We follow our partners in the knowledge of the program often still ignored, in the preparation of the activities and the volunteer. Currently among our partners we have: Abusuan Intercultural Center, Pino Pascali Foundation for Contemporary Art, Sputnik Comics Festival, BIG Bari International Gender Festival etc.

■ **KA2 strategic partnership:** we also deal with these projects in the youth field, in order to carry on our values and objectives in a transversal way. We are currently preparing to implement an approved project of which we are partners, which concerns the deconstruction of male / female roles through art, and we are developing a new project to protect ESC volunteers and which aims to improve the program itself.

■ We are constantly participating in training courses that allow us to grow and improve as an association and personally, we point out the participation of MOH a:

1 ) We have been selected to participate in the **DICA Europe** project: we will help our association to grow through the financial resources of the European Union. The aim is to learn how to develop project proposals in line with the standards of the European Commission, aimed at project management for social design.

2 ) We have successfully participated in: "'Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs' at 'elan interculturel' and our story is one of success stories. "Excellent and fruitful experience"

3 ) **Interreg Traces:** The TRACES project aims to promote creative entrepreneurship and the growth of cultural and creative enterprises in Puglia.
