
# BUILDING RAINBOWS: ART AS A MEDIATOR



### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project 'Building Rainbows' is an experiential interescetion of the world of arts and the concept of peace education, which will be used in an attempt to build bridges of communication as well as to de-construct the existence of mental and geographical borders. The project will take place in the torn-apart island of Cyprus, which has long suffered the consequences of conflict and division, and the wounds are still alive in geographical, anthropological and sociological levels.

The main aim of the project is to use artistic practices, to enhance our understanding about the above concepts, and to use non-formal methods as a way of developing on a personal level as well as to encourage stronger social connections and initiate creative dialogue. Throughout the project, a plethora of art media will be used to address the concepts of peace education.

The project is funded by Erasmus+ and there is no participation fee.

# PRACTICALITIES (WHEN, WHERE, FOR WHO)

The project will take place in Amiantos Village, which is located in the highest mountain range of the island, Troodos, between 11-19 of September (including 2 days of traveling), and will bring together participants from Cyprus, Greece, Bulgaria, Poland, Italy and Spain (5 from mainland & 5 from canary islands). (4 Participants and 1 Youth Leaders)

### For whom?

- Curious individuals aging between 18-30
- Youth who are interested in the topics of arts and peace education, are motivated to participate, and are open to the process of growing collectively through giving and receiving.
- The call is open for everyone, no matter on educational, financial or social status.
- The group leaders (no age limit) should be able to communicate in English and in their group's mother tongue, are experienced in Erasmus+ projects, and have some organization skills. This is a great opportunity for aspiring youth workers to get some in-action experience. They will be asked to offer workshops and coordinate the reflection groups.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- A plethora of artistic practices, workshops and activities, including and not limited to: poetry, storytelling, visual arts, arts & crafts, circus arts, movement and music.
- Fabrika, will offer sufficient resources, and creative freedom for all the participants to be able to create and express.
- Special focus will be given on the concepts of peace education and non-violent communication.
- Nature-based activities, enhancing interpersonal and personal learning, working in groups as well as with our own self.
- A safe space in which we will host our ideas and concerns, where we will listen to each other as well as a space in which we can be ourselves without judgmental nor stereotypical behaviors.



### TRAVEL



The travel costs are covered by Erasmus+ and will be reimbursed after the project takes place, based on the original travel documents (tickets and Boarding Passes) and participant's reports regarding their follow-up activities. ### FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

During the project, we will be offering seasonal, mediterrenean, delicious vegan plates, full of colour, love and nutritions. As we are advocates of peace and non-violence, we are gonna start from omitting the violence in our plates.

### CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- The participation in this project presupposes the agreement of the covid strategy introduced by the organizing team (covid strategy), which in this case briefly translates to our inability to cover the cost of the PCR tests, as it was not included in the initial budget. All participants should have the medical insurance covered prior to their arrival.
- The full participation and collaboration throughout the preparation, implementation and follow-up phases of the project. In case of arriving to the project and not engaging with the workshops and activities (without any rational reasoning), then we cannot reimburse the costs.
