- experince with sewing, working with textile



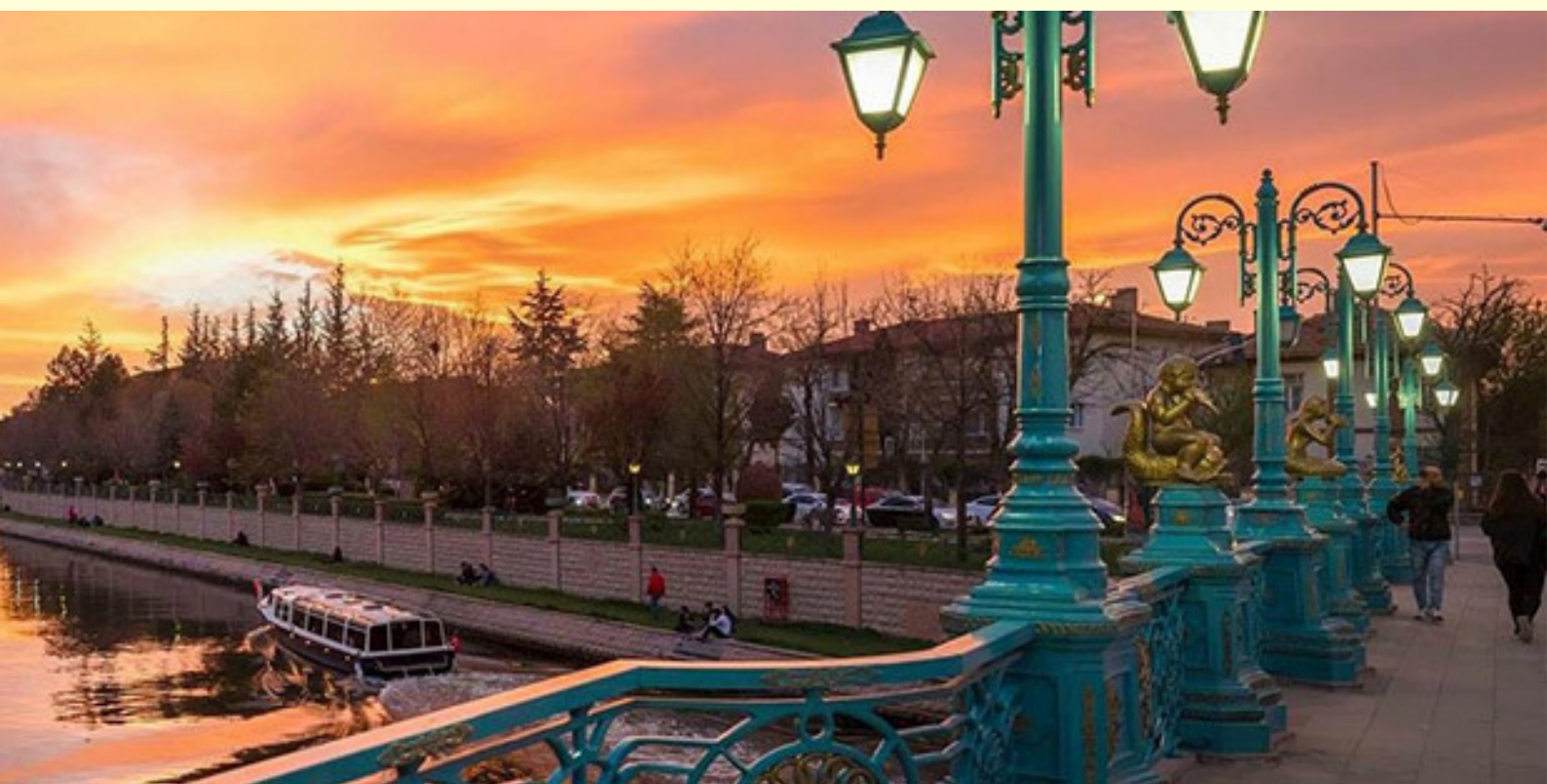
Accommodation: Volunteers will be provided with accommodation. The house / apartment will be located in the center of Eskisehir and will be provided to our volunteers with a fully equipped kitchen, toilet, laundry facilities and living room with a single bedroom and bedroom

Food and pocket money: Volunteers will receive 4 euros per day for food and 120 euros pocket money per month

Travel costs: all the travel expenses will be reimbursing according to the EU distance calculator

Insurance and Social Security: Our volunteers will be covered by travel and health insurance

Visa: We will determine the visa costs from the schedule specified on the website of our Ministry of Foreign Affairs and add them to the project budget items as exceptional expenses.



Working hours: 40 hours per week , free weekend and extra 2 days free every month
