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BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE AND STAFF DESCRIPTION

Einai Foundation /since 2021/ is a non-governmental non-profit organization that acts locally and internationally for non-formal education especially in philosophy and law, human rights and democratic values areas. Our other activity is research and development in philosophy of law, ethics & responsibility, creative thinking, variety of modes of thinking, process & decision making models, human potential, personal capacity for engagement in democratic society.

Types of actions: discussion club meetings, workshops, research, conferences, youth forum, debates, creating alternative tools for non-formal education which can be used also in schools, innovation for education, social media campaigns, advocacy, counselling, local community building, structure dialogue.

Our main goals consist of educational, didactic, scientific and research activity mainly in the field of philosophy and law, but also taking up other important areas of human and social life. It is of utmost importance for the Foundation to use the methods and tools used in these areas to improve responsible attitudes and promote ethical values. Bearing in mind the ongoing civilizational changes around the world, the Foundation aims to support practices that create an active community that engages in social life. She has made a series of podcasts for adults and children on the commission of Silesia Film Institution. In cooperation with Joanna Bronisławska and Chamber Orchestra of Tychy City "AUKSO" she creates radio plays for children based on children books "Gama i pasażerowie" published by PWM. She had finished first scholarship in Poland organized by "Teatr Polskiego Radia" and "Szkoła Wajdy". Since 2018 she has been leading experimental radio broadcasts together with Weronika Stencel for which she had received distinction in the journalist competition "SILESIA PRESS 2019" and the main prize in a Festival in the name of M. Her work included various activities, from lessons to fitness, and her participants ranged in age from 3 to 20 years. Her education includes studies in Library Science and Scientific-Technical Information, where she obtained Pedagogical Qualifications. Furthermore, she gained knowledge in Fairy Tale Therapy, which adds an interesting element to her work with children. In 2020, she completed postgraduate studies in Human Resources Management, enriching her skills in personnel management. It's also worth noting her achievements in Mental Training.
