

Results of Survey 2020-2021 NEED ANALYSIS OF THE SOS PROJECT

568 international students from 56 different nationalities participated in the SOS survey. A total of 40 questions were asked to the students. Questions are tested and open-ended. The resulting results will be detailed in the needs analysis book



According to the results of the field studies, the most important problems of international students are about scholarship, cultural barriers and educational difficulties.
