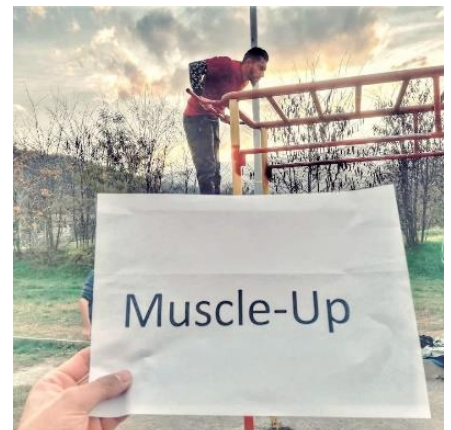

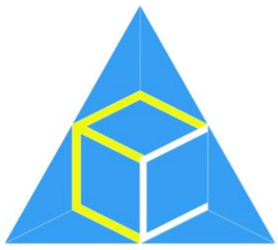
Activities

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The city of Bitola

Bitola is a city in the southwestern part of North Macedonia. It is located in the southern part of the Pelagonia valley, surrounded by the Baba, Nidže and Kajmakčalan mountain ranges, 14 kilometres north of the Medžitlija-Níki border crossing with Greece. Bitola, known during the Ottoman Empire as Manastır or Monastir, is one of the oldest cities in North Macedonia.



If you are a mountain lover, Bitola is surrounded by the narcissistic beauty of Baba mountain with its Pelister peak, stretching with the wild nature and hidden paths that lead to many hiking points. The top is hiding the eyes of Pelister, two mesmerizing glacier lakes, that will take your breath away. And of course, if you are a coffee lover, starting from the tower clock, all the way to the “Tumbe café” hill, the “Shirok Sokak” wide pedestrian street is lined with cafes, restaurants and sweetshops.
