SUMMARY

This youth exchange aims to contribute to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the heart of Agenda 2030. Our activation in support of the Goals can only take place when we are aware of them and fully understand them. Knowing and understanding them means creating ways to achieve them. Bringing young people together at the European level to exchange ideas, share experiences means giving them tools to collaborate to achieve common goals. Supporting young people in creating and developing innovative solutions, means giving them the capacity to increasingly involve young people and communities, offering their own perspective and giving space to the action of the other.

MAIN GOALS

- offer a space for meeting, dialogue and analysis.
- Improve understanding of SDGs and the role they can play in recovery;
- Facilitate understanding of how youth participation and activation is a key aspect of recovery and achievement of the SDGs:
- Promote the encounter between young people from different cultures and backgrounds and increase understanding and cooperation between them;
- To build the capacity of young people to design and implement initiatives, projects and activities in line with the SDGs;
- Identify opportunities for the inclusion of young people in civic and political participation and in the implementation of the SDGs;
- Empowering young people as changemakers by providing them with useful and practical tools through which to develop awareness-raising actions;
- Develop actions on the SDGs for awareness-raising, information and/or training;
- Promote the opportunities offered by the Erasmus+ Programme and the European Solidarity Corps and increase knowledge of the methods and tools of non-formal education.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

- interest in taking part in a multicultural experience (give priority to people who have had few or no opportunities to live experiences of this type and/or experience intercultural learning activities);
- interest in the topic of the youth exchange;
- a basic level of English;
- Group Leaders: preferably between 25 and 35 y.o and with previous experiences in ErasmusPlus projects and a good knowledge of English.





ACCOMODATION

The Youth exchange will be held in Belorado, a village belonging to the Province of Burgos. The venue of the exchange will be Albergue Belorado El Corro and it is essential and adequate to host the entire group. There will be different rooms (divided by gender) and different bathrooms. There is no bathroom towel service available. We also ask you to bring personal things such as your shampoo, gel, etc. The three daily meals will be served in the accommodation. The beds are equipped with bottom sheet and we have blankets; however, a SHEET OR SLEEPING BAG IS NEEDED.

The selected venue has an activity room with all the necessary facilities which we can use.

WHAT TO PREPARE

- Two warm up;
- Intercultural evening: presenting your country through typical food, games, dances;





TRAVEL & TRANSPORTS

Arrival / Departure airport must be Madrid (the closest to the venue of the project).

Arrivals to Madrid on the 25th before 5.00 pm if possible. Departures from Madrid on the 1st after 12:00 pm, if possible.

We will provide the participants with **a bus from Madrid airport** to the accommodation on 25th. The bus will leave from Madrid Airport Terminal4 around 17:00 (to confirm depending on your arrival).

We will also provide the participants with a bus from the accommodation to Madrid airport on 1st. The bus will leave from the venue around 7:00 (to confirm depending on your departure). Using a private bus for all the group will help us to avoid other contacts before the project.

The travel costs will be covered up to the amount based on distance calculator. Food and accommodation will be 100% covered. Please note we will deduct 40 € from the travel amount of each participant in order to cover the travel by bus from Madrid airport till the venue of the project and back.

Please note that to participate in the youth exchange you must have a **European Health Card or equivalent insurance**.



COVID-19 SPECIAL MEASURES

We kindly ask that all participants arrive on the first day of the project and try to use the bus provided.

We want to avoid unnecessary complications and create a safe and secure working environment. At the end of the project it is possible to stay 2 days more in Spain at one's own expense and to be reimbursed for the travel.



Participants should be vaccinated or recovered from Covid-19, otherwise they will not be allowed to get involved in the activities. Brújula Intercultural will cover all the mandatory Covid tests needed, inside the travel budget (since there is not a budget for this) and will cover the costs of the self-tests that will be used to monitor the situation during the period of the exchange.

We kindly ask participants to buy an insurance, to cover the costs in case of quarantine. We will not be able to cover nor the cost of the insurance, nor the costs of quarantine, but will support the participants to find an accommodation for the quarantine and help them in everything they will need.





We kindly ask you to select your participants by 18th April and to send us **possible travel options**.

Once we have agreed on the best travel option, we can quickly proceed with the purchase of the tickets.

REIMBURSEMENT



It is mandatory that all participants keep boarding passes and travel purchase invoices, as well as other documents and invoices relating to costs that can be included in the travel budget, such as visas and covid diagnostic tests.

At the end of the project, when we receive all the necessary documents for reimbursement (in digital format if they are in digital format and/or in physical format [to be given in person or sent later by post]) we will make the total reimbursement of the groups to the sending organisations or to one of the group leaders.
