

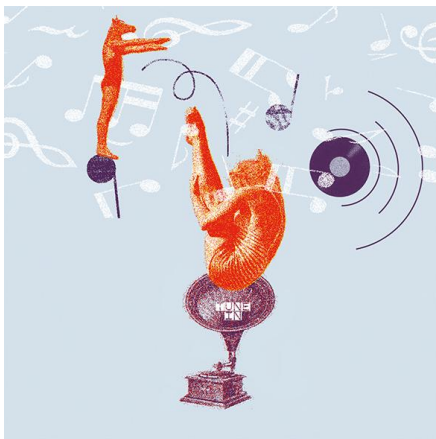
Project proposal

Project proposal

Project objective:

This international training course 'Music & Youthwork' aims to bring youth workers together with different experiences in the field of music and/or youthwork to learn how we can use the richness of music in youth work activities.



A lot of research tells us how important music can be in the development of children. Also in youthwork, listening to and creating music together can be very useful for gaining personal strength and creating better group dynamics. That's why we feel the importance of sharing experiences and methods in playing, creating and enjoying music with a group of children. In this international training course we'll focus on non-formal education activities and workshops about where music meets youthwork.

Youth Workers from 18+ who work or volunteer with children and are interested in the field of music.

Who are we?

Koning Kevin is a non-profit organisation acknowledged by the Flemish Government as Youth Work. Our purpose is to stimulate and encourage a responsible, playful and animated attitude in children and youth. We organise activities that focus quite a lot on creativity. We include music, visual arts, media, movement and theater. We work with a staff of 9 people and almost 200 volunteers.

What do we do?

We provide training to youngsters who want to work with youth on a voluntary basis. Therefore we have our own series of courses and we provide internships for them in our own organization. During the summer we organise summer camps with a strong focus on creativity. Our volunteers are all trained by Koning Kevin. The organisation has a large tradition in experimenting and working with art education and game-methods.

Requirements and expectations for partners

Requirements for partners:

- Have a PIF (with OID) from the European Commission
- Be able to send a group of 10 youth workers who are 18+ and 2 trainers who are experienced in working with music and children (age unlimited), who have sufficient English skills and interest in the project.
- Willing to actively participate in creating this project (partner meetings, programme of the youth exchange ...)

Project partner will be in charge of:

- selecting two group leaders
- selecting, preparing and coordinating participants (young people) from their community/country
- supporting the project's implementation, evaluation, decision-making and learning process
- contributing to coordination meetings, as well as to activities to be held during the youth exchange.
- willing to host this project in your country.
