Back ground:

The project name is **H-MACS (HIV- Mothers and Children Support)** which means the services or assistance was given to mothers living with HIV and their families.All in all Mothers, children, men and pregnant mothers benefitted from the fund.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Each of those 3 communities Namigavu, Matte (Mityana) and Kasubi Kampala where our beneficiaries stay were given bars of washing soap, 6kgs of posho, and a kilogram of silver fish.

25 pregnant mothers at Kasubi were given posho, silver fish, soap and powdered milk.

20 children were given bread and sugar in Matte village in Mityana.

We were able to give care and treatment to about 4 bedridden patients in Kampala kasubi 1 in busunju mityana

We gave covid awareness messages to two communities in Kampala and wakiso.

CHALLENGES

- Many community members wanted to benefit but we controlled by use of the community local leaders.

- The covid period limited the number of beneficiaries.
- Clean water provision to Namigavu Mityana
- Less number of beneficiaries served
