## C. Background and experience

## Please briefly present the partner organisation

Asociación Sociocultural BreGal is an association born in 2021 in Galicia, Spain. The main objective of the association is the promotion of volunteering experiences and non-formal education activities in the framework of the Erasmus+ programme, providing opportunities for young Galicians to travel abroad and live intercultural experiences, as well as for young Europeans to get to know Galicia, its society and its culture.

The association was founded by former volunteers who met and forged a friendly relationship during their volunteering period and who, after detecting that they were also united by a desire to revalue volunteering experiences in Galicia, decided to take a step forward and formalise the creation of the association.

The main topics on which the association focuses are social inclusion, youth empowerment, the promotion of an ecologically and socially sustainable lifestyle, boosting employability of youngsters and the defence of European values.

## What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

All BreGal members have participated in different youth projects and exchanges, and are used to working through non-formal education methods. At the same time, all members have already completed their period of volunteering, in which they have carried out different tasks regarding the management of an association: from office work, planning, creation and development of European projects, facilitation of non-formal learning activities, etc.

All our members are also very active in the field of political and social participation in their respective communities, and have a strong background in working altruistically for positive social change in accordance with the values of solidarity, respect, inclusion and appreciation of multiculturalism promoted by the European institutions.

## Please give information on the key staff/persons involved in this application and on the competences and previous experience that they will bring to the project.

Federico Giordano, International mobility coordinator: Federico is a journalist who graduated in 2015. After finishing his studies he started working for the tax management company 60Días. At the same time, he began to collaborate with various Galician media, in particular with O Salto Diario, always focused on social issues that concern the regional and local socio-political context.

At the end of 2018, he stopped working in 60Días, and started his experience in the world of volunteering and mobility. He participates as a leader in the Youth4Europe project and in other youth exchanges. It is through these experiences that he starts to be interested in the world of non-formal education. After participating in other youth exchanges, he decides to take a step forward and start training himself for being a trainer and project manager. In July 2019, he began to do long-term volunteer work in project management with Associazione Kora. During his stay at Kora he carried out various tasks ranging from organising and managing projects, managing social networks, facilitating exchanges, and even writing three youth exchanges. He also acquires and strengthens its knowledge in the field of European mobility, inter-organisational communication, and mentoring. In August 2020 he founded in Germany an informal group of young people, DOPE, together with other volunteers, being this his first attempt to create an organization. However, and even when DOPE already organized its first projects and it's a still active organization, Federico never forgot his idea of creating a Galician association, and he has been working with Oscar in the creation of BreGal since 2019, and they took the step forward in 2021.

Oscar Fernandez Gonzalez, Secretary: Oscar has a degree in History and a Master in European Studies. In 2013, he worked as an Erasmus intern in the International Relationship Office of the University of Cagliari performing duties linked with the management and administration of the Erasmus+ program. After finishing his studies in 2018 he got involved in several mobility projects. Willing to take an active role in organizing and implementing cultural activities as well as international exchanges, he participated in the European Solidarity Corps program under a long-term project called "Mission Tradition" in Cyprus. There, Oscar had the opportunity of acquiring experience and knowledge related with event planning, project management and non-formal education. Once back in

Spain, Oscar worked together with Federico in the foundation of BreGal. Nowadays, he works in Italy in the field of educational mobility.

Martina Millenat, Administration Department: Martina has a Master in Cultural Sciences with specialisation in cultural management, cultural sociology and pop culture research. After studying she made an internship as "European project manager" in the french associations IDC and ADHC where she organized and co-facilitated a Youth Exchange. In July 2020 she started a long-term ESC volunteering with Associazione Kora, where she is also working on administrative tasks, project management and facilitation. Martina is also one of the funders of DOPE together with Federico, and they have been working together since her arrival to Kora, which lead to her being invited to join BreGal.
