D. BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE	
Please briefly present the partner organization.	<p>The NGO was established in 2017 with the purpose of underlaying sport activities. According to our status we are a non-commercial organization which can provide a number of sports trainings, such as tennis and ski. The main objective is to teach sports to any person who is interested, without any differences of age, culture, race and religion.</p> <p>We aim to fight against discrimination and racism through sports and youthwork, contribute to social inclusion through sports and to bring people together from different environments and cultures using physical activities.</p>

	<p>Because we want to help young people and adults, we have started working in Erasmus plus projects and we aim to create and implement youth projects, based on development of multicultural communications, cultural diversity, interreligious dialogue and tolerance in a civil society, also with the help of sport activities.</p> <p><u>Strategy of the organization:</u> Creation of a new layer of young people and adults with liberal ideas, ready to work for the welfare of the people of their country and to cooperate in the spirit of tolerance and partnership with other nations.</p> <p><u>Object of the organization:</u> To support the development of a creative, energetic and healthy person having an active civil position.</p> <p><u>Aims of the organization:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To develop the creative potential of people in general • To promote sports and introduce it as a daily activity in people's lives • To promote and support a healthy lifestyle through sports and personal development • To support youth initiatives in various fields • To create conditions for active involvement of young people both into social, economic and cultural life of the society • To make sports more accessible to people, even for people living in an underdeveloped social and economic environment • Encouragement for self-actualization of a free individual • To promote equality and social inclusion through sport • To support fair-play and sportsmanship conduct in society as a social concept • To develop the international youth cooperation, to cooperate with foreign youth organizations
<p>What are the activities and experience of the organization in the areas relevant for this application?</p>	<p>The organization has as main experience in holding sport activities such tennis and skiing courses for any level of practitioners. Organizing tennis and skiing lessons for individuals of any age, sport events and competitions.</p> <p>Promoting a healthy lifestyle through sports, helping individuals also struggling with weight problems. Since the beginning the organization works with youth from foster homes, helping them develop social skills and be included in the society through sports and volunteering. Some of the youth part of this program also have physical or mental disabilities. By teaching them tennis or ski, it helps them integrate better in society, boost their confidence, develop social and personal skills and also determine them to take better care of their health.</p> <p>Another part of our organization's activity is offering leadership training for youth workers who want to mentor youngsters, in partnership with an international organization. This also offers experience in organizing trainings and non-formal courses.</p> <p>Working with both youth and adults offered us a lot of experience in social working especially as we succeeded in changing mentalities in our community, where people did not understand the value of volunteering.</p> <p>At the present moment we have a few international partner NGOs from Italy, Spain, Germany and Bulgaria for Erasmus plus projects, where we are sending participants from Romania, to take part in their youth exchanges or training courses.</p> <p>We developed an online platform designated to youth and adults to be informed about upcoming projects and to subscribe at Erasmus plus projects.</p> <p>In September 2022 we are part of a Erasmus + youth worker training course in Paola, Italy, implemented by Copernicus Berlin. with the support of Associazione Minerva. It involves 34 youth workers (20+), from 6 different countries (Germany, Spain, Romania, Bulgaria, Estonia and Italy). This project is in line with the objectives of the Erasmus + program, by training 34 youth workers, members of youth organizations, among other actors involved in the youth and sport sector to improve the level of basic skills and abilities of young people, including young people with fewer opportunities, and to promote their inclusion in society through sports and the labor market, active citizenship, intercultural dialogue and common EU values, creating more mobility opportunities for learning purposes.</p>
