TRANSPORTATION

Airport Shuttle

From the Ankara (esenboga) airport, you should take the bus called belko air the one goes towards kızılai. You should get off the bus at Güvenpark (Kızılay) stop. A one-way bus ticket to the city centre costs 27.00 TL (€1.50).

Public bus

The only public bus line that departs from Ankara Esenboğa Airport is bus line 442 which operates from 6 am to 11 pm. The bus stop can be found in front of the passenger exit doors on the Arrivals floor of both the Domestic and International terminals.
