Project Proposal:

Hello everybody!

“We need stories that inspire and connect us, rather than tearing us further apart; stories that paint a hopeful picture of the future we share and stories told by migrants themselves.” Come together with young people to think and share the migration stories to raise awareness and find similar patterns in each different story. Every young person has a different story. Story sharing will help us overcome the issues in our lives and help us build a future together.



During this international exchange project, we will host five groups from Europe and bring them together with a group of Turkish youngsters to discuss/dissect/break taboos of migration. In a playful and creative way, we will explore what different stories are leading us to similar positions in life and what themes we have in common as young people in Europe and Turkey. During this project, we will work towards an artistic end product which is a digital migration story, but the main focus of this project is non-formal learning and the personal learning process that the participants will go through during this week.

Participants

Youngsters in the age between 18 to 30 years old. It is necessary that participants are prepared for the activities, and ready to share and learn more. Participants need to be motivated to follow the activities and be a part of the projects. They should be interested in meeting new people, and cultures and open to learning about others and their stories.

- Willing to actively participate in creating this project (partner meetings, the program of the youth exchange, etc.)

The project partner will be in charge of:

- Selecting the group leader without an age limit
- Selecting, preparing, and coordinating participants in their country (helping them in deciding the travel routes, making sure they have the latest updates, etc.)
- Ensure that participants have the all information about the project and have no doubts
- Supporting the project's implementation, evaluation, decision-making, and learning process. Participating in coordination meetings, as well as activities to be held during the youth exchange.
- Carrying out preparation activities with the group before the activities as a form of a pre-departure preparing
- Take measures aimed at promoting the visibility of the project and the visibility of the Erasmus+ Programme
- Supporting the participants after the project on administrative needs such as reimbursement process, evaluation form, and so on
