





Mustafa Kemal ATATURK 1881-1938

- Founder of the Republic of Turkey
- 1st president of Turkey
- Fought in 10 battles
- Started the War of Independence
- Wrote 9 books
- Countless reforms

He died on **10th of November 1938**. His monumental tomb "Anıtkabir" is in Ankara.


