BRIEF PRESENTATION OF OUR GROUP

Climate Volunteers (CLIVO) is an informal group founded by a group of high school and university students in 2021 in Antalya. We have different backgrounds, but we focus on the Climate Act, Sustainable Lifestyle, and Green Entrepreneurship altogether. Our mission is to raise climate change awareness in our community and support young people to gain sustainable habits and start green entrepreneurship. We believe that the world can be better with our efforts and through sustainable actions. Our group consists of 15 people with mostly students, a few researchers and trainers.

We are committed ourselves to a sustainable future and we want to improve the social, economic, and environmental well-being of our community through our Climate Acts. We are dedicated to environmental improvements that foster a sustainable future leading to social and economic improvements in our community. Our goal is to help protect the environment for generations to come. Our group is new, so we want to meet young people from different parts of Europe and work on Youth Projects cooperatively.

CLIVO is highly motivated to focus on:

- creating international projects to provide opportunities for young people in Türkiye
- encouraging young people to become more active citizens in their societies
- promoting tolerance, diversity and understanding the different cultures in Europe and in our country as well
- creating a lifelong learning environment for people we interact.

OUR ACTIVITIES AND EXPERIENCE RELEVANT FOR THIS PROJECT

Our local area, Döşemealtı is about 25 km away from Antalya city center. The inhabitants are mostly farmers which makes the social and economic profile of local people quite low. Therefore, we prefer working with disadvantaged young people in our projects, events, and trainings.

Our Municipality opened a new Youth Center in 2019. This center welcomes the local children, teens, and youth and gives those opportunities to fill their free time with sports, music, drama, and other social and cultural activities. Also, it has a conference hall, swimming pool, music room, and library where CLIVO members do volunteer work.

Although it has not been a long time since we formed our informal group, the group members have known each other for a long time and some of them have been very active in EU projects, youth work, and volunteering for several years. For example:

-Some participants in the group have implemented Erasmus+ KA1 & KA2 projects in the school education and youth field

-Our director has already mentored some young people doing EVS in Antalya.

-1 of the youth leaders (Hüseyin Çağlar İnce <https://www.dogadabuan.com/>) has committed himself to educating people from 7 to 70 about nature, climate change, sustainable tourism, birdwatching, and biodiversity.

-Our high school has Climate Change Education as an extracurricular activity

-We attend EU project development training, write projects, use international platforms, and grow our



collaboration with the youth from other countries.

CLIVO is growing rapidly. We have already two youth projects approved in 2022 and 1 project approved in 2024. They were fantastic learning experience for our young participants. They made many new friends from all different cultures and made lifelong memories along the way. They said the youth exchange helped broaden their perspective and see the world from different points of view. They would continue to use all the skills that they learned and improve on them in the future, both in their personal life and work/other projects. Given the chance, they would undoubtedly go again.
