<p>Please briefly present the partner organisation.</p>	<p>Koning Kevin is a non-profit organisation acknowledged by the Flemish Government as Youth Work. Our purpose is to stimulate and encourage a responsible, playful, and animated attitude in children and youngsters.</p> <p>We organise activities which focus on creativity. We include music, visual arts, media, movement, theatre, game-methods, and the development of social competences. We work with a staff of 9 people and more than 250 volunteers.</p>
<p>What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?</p>	<p>We provide training to youngsters who want to work with young people on a voluntary basis. Therefore, we have our own series of courses and we provide internships for them in our own organisation.</p> <p>We provide training and education to a wide range of youth organisations and schools.</p> <p>During the summer, we organise summer camps for children and youngsters from the age of 3 until the age of 26. The camps have a strong focus on creativity and personal development and are guided by our volunteers. All volunteers are trained by Koning Kevin.</p> <p>The organisation has a long tradition of experimenting and working with art education, game-methods and the development of social competences.</p>
<p>What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?</p>	<p>For every project, we compose a group of volunteers who will (supported by a project manager) be in charge of the project and make sure the project stays on the right track.</p> <p>When forming the group, we take the following things into account: the background and experience of every member; their personal motivation; their competences; and their complementarity with other group members.</p> <p>The volunteers are coached and guided by Hanne Geerens, who works at Koning Kevin in the function of education and project manager. Her daily tasks are the development of new educational methods and developing new projects.</p>
