D. Background and Experience

Please briefly present the partner organisation.

Intensify World was founded in 2019 by three young engineers, in Macieira de Rates, a rural parish in the municipality of Barcelos in northern Portugal. Its purpose is to promote a positive transformation of its local community, through the promotion of actions that generate opportunities that could contribute to the resolution of existing social problems. Our action is
