


Our projects cover a wide range of topics aligned with our commitment to corporate sustainability and greener careers for youth. Examples of completed works include:

- Two volunteer upskilling programmes with Emeis Global and TEAM NEST, which were remote and flexible;
- Biodiversity finance project with Octopolis Foundation.
- 15+ Erasmus+ KA1 projects on a variety of sustainability topics

These projects helped volunteers learn about SCRUM, business planning, technological tools, social entrepreneurship, sustainability consulting, and several other skills, <u>enhancing their professional networks and employability.</u>

- Easysustainability, despite being well below the thresholds for obligatory reporting, is preparing its financial statement with the non-profit accounting principle <u>OIC 35</u>.
- Regarding sustainability reporting, we are preparing the correspondent of a sustainability report with model C "relation of mission", and also integrated a report with the <u>EFRAG VSME</u> standard for 2025.
- We experienced a funding growth of more than 3000% from 2024 to 2025, almost exclusively coming from won Erasmus+ projects. From 2026, we envision a further growth thanks to pending Erasmus+ applications.
- Following venture philanthropy principles, we are available to run a
 positive impact materiality assessment for projects sponsored in
 alignment with ESRS, GRI and other leading principles.
