Within Erasmus+, a training course is a project where youth workers and youth leaders come together for several days to develop their knowledge, skills, and attitudes on a certain theme. The daily programme of the course is based on learning objectives and facilitated by experienced trainers. The training courses promote the initiative and creativity of participants and have a direct impact on their future youth work or youth policy activities, such as organising quality projects and providing intercultural and non-formal learning experiences for young people.

Altogether, **28** people took part in the project.

### The overall aim and specific objectives of the project:

- To provide youth workers & leaders with knowledge, skills and attitudes that will help them better address conflict situations that arise in their youth work and promote a culture of peace;
- To offer non-formal learning activities that provide opportunities to practice skills and knowledge for addressing conflict;
- To promote the core EU values of respect for human rights, non-violence, social cohesion & diversity as well as cooperation under the Erasmus+ programme.

### Main contents and activities of the project:

The activities aimed at exploring the complex nature of conflict and its various aspects, encouraging competence development in the field of non-violent conflict transformation, conflict resolution and recognizing the important role of youth work as a response to conflict and violence affecting young people.
